## **THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT**

### **FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE**

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**

## II. ENTRIES

### Date of Invitation

Tuesday 26th May 2009

### Entries Closing Date and Fees

**Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June at 5pm.** All entries must be made using the prescribed forms attached. Entries may be made in person at the BTSC Riding School Office, or by post or fax. Entry fee for each Class is as shown in the competition schedule.

### **ALL COMPETITORS TO NOTE**

IMPORTANT The Draws for Dressage Classes will be done no later than 10<sup>th</sup> June. **Changes to the Dressage Draws will not be permitted after this time.** Competitors with specific time preferences or riding more than one horse should indicate their preferred order **ON THEIR ENTRY FORM**, however the Organizers can only commit to fulfil these requests on a best efforts basis.

Changes to the Draws for the Jumping Classes will not be permitted once published. Competitors riding more than one horse in a Class should indicate their preferred order **ON THEIR ENTRY FORM**. Late Entries may be accepted to the beginning of Jumping Class Draws as below.

### Late Entries

Entries received after the closing date will be considered as Late Entries. The Late Entry fee is **double** the normal entry fee. Late Entries for Dressage and flat equitation will be taken up to **5 pm 10<sup>th</sup> June**. Late entries for Jumping may be taken up to **30 min before the Class starts**. Late Entries will start first in any Class. This however is up to the decision of the show director.

**Note floating and stabling cannot be guaranteed for Late Entries.**

### Entry, Waiver & Acknowledgement Forms

EFS 2009 Waiver Forms (Annex A) must be submitted together with the entry forms to BTSC by **5<sup>th</sup> June at 5pm**. Competitors without completed Forms will not be allowed to compete. **For 2009, EFS Registered Riders need only submit Waiver Forms once during the year.** New EFS subscriptions must be paid to the EFS Office together with completed EFS Registration Form prior to the Competition. **All competitors must be EFS Registered 2009.**

### Payment of Entries

All payments will be charged directly through the respective Club account. Failing to submit all entry fees may result in disallowance of competitors from Competition.

### Veterinary/Medical Scratching

Entries cancelled after the Entries Closing Date on **5<sup>th</sup> June at 5pm** must be verified with a Veterinary or Medical Certificate for a 50% refund of the entry fee provided that the cancellation is done before the commencement of the Competition. No refunds will be given for scratching for any other reason.

### III. RULES & REGULATIONS

#### General Rules

The BTSC Singapore Summer Show is an EFS sanctioned Inter-Club Show organised under the following Rules:

FEI General Rules and Regulations, 23<sup>rd</sup> Ed. Effective 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2009, FEI Rules for Jumping Events 23<sup>rd</sup> Ed, effective 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2009, FEI Rules for Dressage Events 23<sup>rd</sup> Ed. Effective 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2009, EFA Dressage Competition Rules effective 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2008 (updated: 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2009) and EFS Sports Rules for Equitation Jumping (2008) effective 21<sup>st</sup> Aug 2008.

In-House competitions

For saddle horse events rules will be taken from the EFA saddle horse guidelines [www.efa.vic.gov](http://www.efa.vic.gov)

In any circumstances where FEI, EFA or EFS rules are not available, the **Organising Committee** will have the authority to make decisions.

Jumping Classes 23,25,27, 29 and 31 – 36 will run under FEI Rules for Jumping Events, specifically under Table A (FEI Jumping Rules Art. 236) and judged according to Art. 238.1.1 or 2.2. For Class(es) 90cm and under, Table A will be modified as follows:

#### In House Rules

Competitors must wear a helmet with 3 or 4 point harness correctly fastened at all times when mounted. (exception only for FEI Tests at PSG and above when a top hat may be worn warming up immediately prior to the competitors allotted time).

**The designated competition arenas are out of bounds to all riders from Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June 12pm onwards. This includes dressage rings & jumping set ups. Any riders caught riding in these areas will be disqualified. There will be designated areas to work your horses.**

#### Paradise/Terra Arenas

Riders should introduce themselves to the Steward on entering the Warm up Ring.

Riders warming up should pass left hand to left hand. In general, the faster pace has priority AND SLOWER HORSES SHOULD GIVE WAY. Lateral work has overall priority.

Tack adjustment, horses standing etc should take place off the track and away from horses working. Coaches and helpers must not impede or interrupt other horses using the practice arenas.

Exercising, hacking and grazing of visiting horses at all other times must comply with the Club Rules and is entirely at the Competitor's own risk.

### **Stabling**

Requests for stabling must accompany the Entry Form. Day stabling is available free of charge. Limited overnight stabling is available on a first-come basis at S\$20 per horse per day.

Stabling cannot be guaranteed for Late Entries.

The Competition grounds and stable areas must be kept clean and tidy at all times. No littering.

Washing down of horses should be done in the wash bays only and not inside the stables.

The dung/waste must be removed from the stable daily and disposed of in the proper manner. At the end of the competition, all stables must be cleared of all dung and waste.

### **Horse Passport**

Passports must be available upon entry into BTSC

### **Vaccination Certificate**

All horses and ponies intending to participate in this Competition should possess the Health Certificate that certified free from Nipah Virus and are required to be immunized against the following:

- a) Equine Influenza (EI)
- b) Japanese B Encephalitis (Jap B)

#### **Note:**

Horses that have already been immunized must show documentary proof that the vaccinations have been performed by the **Official Veterinary Surgeon** or **Government Veterinary Surgeon**. These records must be entered in the horse passport/registration cards. Horses and ponies attempting to enter **WITHOUT** up-to-date vaccinations records will be denied entry to BTSC.

### **Horse Arrival / Departure**

Visiting horses will be allowed in the BTSC stables from Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June-Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June.

### **Insurance**

All Owners and Competitors are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees, their agents and their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in Equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep their policy up-to-date.

### **The Organiser Reserves the Right to**

Refuse any Horse or Competitor.  
Cancel any Event or Class.

Eliminate or disqualify any rider or spectator behaving in an inappropriate manner toward other competitors, spectators or event staff.

Divide any Class.

Alter the advertised times if necessary.

Bill any participating Club the cost of cleaning stables.

## **VI. COMPETITION RULES**

<b><u>Competition Ground</u></b>	Jumping Outdoor Arena 60m x 45m (sand) x2 Dressage Arenas Outdoor 20m x 60m and 20m x 40m (sand)
<b><u>Competition Rules</u></b>	Horses may participate in up to three Classes per day in a single discipline or two Classes each in Dressage and Jumping (including Equitation). School

horses may compete in more Classes (restricted to low level only) if specific permission is obtained from the respective Senior Riding Managers.

If not wearing a competition jacket, a collared light coloured (Dressage) or solid colour (Jumping) short/long sleeve shirts with tie, choker or stock are permitted. Leather chaps of the same colour as jodphur boots are permitted instead of tall boots in all Jumping Classes and in Dressage Classes below FEI Tests. Gloves should be worn in all Dressage Classes (white preferred).

Official Club tee-shirts may be worn in Preliminary Dressage and below, plus in Equitation Jumping and Jumping Classes below 90 cm. Body protectors are permitted in all Classes, but care must be taken with respect to potential heat exhaustion.

Except as noted above, dress, tack and participation must conform to the respective Discipline Rules as follows:

All dressage classes are run under EFA Dressage Rules, except that whip length for horses and ponies cannot exceed 1.20m and 1.00m respectively.

Rising trot is optional for both Preliminary & Novice Tests.

Equitation Classes will run under EFS Sports Rules for Equitation (2008).

For other Classes Rules may be posted during the Show prior to the start of the respective Class.

All instructions from Stewards and Officials are to be followed without dispute or delay, otherwise the Competitor is liable to disqualification or elimination.

### **Prize Giving Ceremony**

For the Dressage Classes and Equitation Jumping Classes, prize giving will take place **unmounted** (unless stated otherwise in the invitation) at the end of each competition session (times to be posted and announced). **Competitors must be neatly dressed in full competition attire as a sign of respect for the Show Sponsors and Officials.** For the Jumping Classes, prize giving will take place **mounted** immediately after each class. **Competitors not attending the Prize Givings with out notifying the Organisers in advance will forfeit Placings and Prizes.**

The prize giving ceremony for the Saddle Horse Classes will take place **immediately** following the Class finish and before competitors leave the Show Ring. All placed competitors should be ready to take part in a victory lap if so requested by the Commentator.

## **Prizemoney Collection**

Prize money will be available for collection from the BTSC Administration Office upon presentation of the Prize vouchers during the following times:  
Monday to Friday between 9am – 12noon  
& 1pm - 5pm.  
Prize vouchers will expire on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2009

## **Appeals**

Appeals against any judging decisions, placings or events impacting the results of any class must be lodged with the Show Director in writing within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the class results. All appeals must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which will be returned in the event the appeal is upheld.

The Appeals Committee will review all appeals and announce its decisions as soon as possible pending the time taken to gather and review evidence. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final.

#### SADDLE HORSE EVENTS

#### INTRODUCING OUR NEW SECTION OF SADDLE HORSE (SHOWING EVENTS)

*Ideal for those starting out in competing or wanting to get young horses used to competitions*

#### DEFINITION OF EVENTS:

**BEGINNER:** Able to walk & Trot assisted or unassisted, has started to establish rising trot.

**INTERMEDIATE:** Able to walk & Trot Unassisted & perform basic school figures, may be asked to canter.

**ADVANCED:** Able to walk, trot canter & able to perform an individual work out containing each pace (restricted to riding school riders)

**OPEN:** For experienced riders who can canter as a group & work out individually.

#### EVENT DEFINITIONS:

**IN HAND:** Horses are presented in the ring unsaddled with a bridle & are led around the ring in walk & trot at the direction of the judge. Handlers are judged on the effectiveness of their ground handling skills in presenting the horse. It is not judged on horses confirmation, manners or paces.

**RIDER:** Judged on the riders position & effectiveness of the aids, conformation & paces of horse is not taken into consideration. Riders will be required to demonstrate their skill on the circle (as a group) and individually as requested by the judge.

**MOUNT MOST SUITABLE:** Judged on the horses suitability as a club horse, with manners taken into consideration. Horses will be required to perform tasks as requested by the judge. Riders may be required to go over poles, pick up an item & mount & dismount.

**RIDDEN:** Judged on presentation, manners & paces. Confirmation is also taken into account. Horses should be able to work individually & as a group on the circle as requested by the judge. Riders' position is not taken into consideration.

**1<sup>ST</sup> - 4<sup>TH</sup> - Place Ribbons each class**  
**Overall Division Winners: 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> Place Sashes**

**OVERALL POINTS ARE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> = 4 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> = 3 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> = 2 points
- 4<sup>th</sup> = 1 point
