THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**

The Late entry fee is **double** the normal entry fee. Entries may be made in person at the Riding School, BTSC Office, by post or fax. Late Entries for the BTSC November Show will be taken up to **5pm on Thursday 19th November 2009**

Note floating and stabling cannot be guaranteed for Late Entries

Entry Cancellation

Entries cancelled after the closing date must be verified with a Veterinarian Medical Certificate for a 50% refund of entry fee. No other refunds will be entertained.

Entry, Waiver & Acknowledgement Forms

Please complete the BTSC and EFS Waiver forms (Annex A) and submit together with the entry forms to the Club by **Tuesday 17th November 2009 at 5pm**. Competitors without completed forms will not be allowed to compete. EFS subscriptions (\$50) must be paid to the EFS office together with completed EFS Registration form prior to the competition for any competitor who has not competed in Singapore in 2009.

For the FEI WJC 2009 & FEI Children's International Jumping 2009 entry confirmation will be emailed. The starting order will be published only after the draw (to take place on Thursday 19th November 2009).

The running order for the Dressage will be emailed after the closing date for late entries.

Entry Fees

Entry fee for each class is as shown in the competition schedule.

Horse Hire Fee

BTSC competitors who wish to hire a school horse will be charged S\$30.00 per horse per class

Payment of Entries

All payments will be charged directly through your respective Club account. Failing to submit all entry fees may result in disallowance of competitors from competition.

III. RULES & REGULATION

General Rules

The FEI World Jumping Challenge 2009, FEI International Children's Jumping 2009 & BTSC November Show 2009 will be organised under the following Rules:

- FEI General Regulations, 23rd edition, effective 1st January 2009
- FEI Veterinary Regulations, 11th edition, effective 1st January 2009
- FEI Rules for Jumping Events 23rd Ed. effective 1st Jan 2009
- FEI World Jumping Challenge Rules 2009
- FEI Rules for Dressage Events 23rd Ed. effective 1st Jan 2009
- EFA Dressage Competition Rules, effective 1st Jan 2008 (Updated 1st Jan 2009)

In any circumstances where FEI, EFA or EFS rules are not available, the **Organising Committee** will have the authority to make decisions. The FEI WJC Rules 2009 is included as a separate attachment to this Invitation.

In House Rules

Warming up during the Competition is only permitted in the designated areas supervised by a Steward.

Exercising, hacking and grazing of visiting horses at all other times must comply with the Club Rules and is entirely at the Competitor's own risk.

The competition grounds and stable area must be kept clean and tidy at all times. No littering.

Washing down of horses should be done in the washing bay only and not inside the stables.

Cooking inside the stable area is not be allowed

You are provided with plastic bags for the disposal of dung and other refuse. The dung/waste must be removed from the sawdust daily and disposed of in a proper manner.

At the end of the competition, all stables must be cleaned of all dung and waste.

The Organiser reserves The right to

Bill any participating Club the cost of cleaning stables.

Alter the advertised times if necessary.

Cancel any event or class.

Divide any class.

Refuse any class, horse or rider.

Veterinary Scratching

Entries cancelled after the Entries Closing Date on **Tuesday 17th November 2009 at 5pm** must be verified with a Veterinary Medical Certificate for a 50% refund of the entry fee provided that the cancellation is done before the commencement of an event.

Horse Passport

Passports must be available upon entry into Bukit Timah Saddle Club.

Vaccination Certificate

Please be informed that all horses and ponies intending to participate in this Competition should possess the Health Certificate that certified free from Nipah Virus and are required to be immunized against the following:

- a) Equine Influenza (EI)
- b) Japanese B Encephalitis (Jap B)

Note:

The FEI requirement for influenza vaccination will be for booster vaccination at **six [6] monthly intervals** as from **1 Jan 2009**. To avoid interruption of the horses' competition schedule, it is permissible to vary the 6 monthly booster date up to 21 days.

Horses that have already been immunized must show documentary proof that the vaccinations have been performed by the **Official Veterinary Surgeon** or **Government Veterinary Surgeon**. These records must be entered in the horse registration cards. Horses and ponies attempting to enter **WITHOUT** up-to-date vaccinations records will be denied entry to the club.

Horse Arrival / Departure

The horses will be allowed in the stables from Tuesday 17th November 2009 to Tuesday 24th November 2009.

Prize Giving Ceremony

1st Prize-Giving Ceremony:

To be held at the competition arena at the end of each Challenge event i.e. Cat A, Cat B and Children's Cat C. **Cat A and Children's Cat C on Saturday 21st November 2009 (am)**. **Cat B on Sunday 22nd November 2009 (am)**. Rosettes will be awarded to all placed riders. Riders must come fully attired and mounted.

2nd Prize-Giving Ceremony:

To be held at the Clubhouse on **Sunday 22nd November 2009**, estimated at 12 noon. Participation rosettes, best turned out, best rider and prizes will be awarded to all participants. All winners and participants to be in smart attire. **Placed riders who do not attend the ceremony will not receive their prizes.**

For the BTSC November Show dressage classes, prize giving will take place dismounted at the end of each competition session (times to be posted). Competitors may be in competition attire or neatly dressed (smart casual) as a sign of respect for the Show sponsors and officials. For the BTSC Children's Classes, prize giving will take place dismounted immediately after each class.

Insurance

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees, their agents and their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in Equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep their policy up-to-date.

Vet Inspection

All participating horses in FEI WJC must pass vet inspection (trot up) as per attached rules. The vet inspection will take place at **4.30pm on Thursday 19th November 2009**, to be followed by draw for 1st rounds of both Cat A, B and Children's Cat C and technical briefing.

All FEI participating riders must be smartly attired during the horse inspection.

There will be an award for the Best Turn-Out horse.

Technical Briefing

All FEI participating riders must attend the compulsory Technical Briefing & Draw for horses, immediately after the Horse inspection, on Thursday 19th November 2009 at BTSC Cluhouse.

IV. COMPETITION RULES

Competition Rules

The FEI WJC & Children's Competition classes 1, 2 & 3 will be held according to the FEI WJC Rules 2009 (http://www.fei.org/Development/FEI_World_Jumping_Challenge/Documents/Rules%20WJC%202009.pdf) & 2009 Rules for Children's Competition (http://www.fei.org/Disciplines/Youth/Jumping_Children/Pages/Rules.aspx). This includes, but is not limited to, eligibility, dress code, tack & equipment, participation and scoring.

For all other classes, including fancy dress, competitors must wear a helmet with a 3 or 4 point harness correctly fastened at all times when mounted. Exception only for Classes 10, 11 & 12 where it is allowed to switch to a top hat (if wearing a tailcoat) just before starting the test.

For classes 4, 5 & 13 if not wearing a jacket, collared light coloured short/long sleeve shirts with tie or choker are permitted, as are official Club tee-shirts. Leather gaiters of the same colour as jodhpur boots are permitted instead of tall boots. Body protectors are permitted, but care must be taken with respect to potential heat exhaustion.

Horses may participate in up to three classes per day, not including Handy Pony or Fancy Dress

Except as noted above, dress, tack and participation must conform to the respective discipline Rules as follows:

Classes 5 to 10 will run under EFA Dressage Competition Rules, except that whip length cannot exceed 1.2m and 1.0m for horses and ponies respectively. Rising trot is optional for Class 7.

Class 11 & 12 will run under FEI Rules for Dressage Events, except that whips may be carried in the test.

Classes 13 & 14 Children's Handy Pony and Fancy Dress are open to all riders and lead line is acceptable for beginner riders. The Organising Committee will split classes 13 and 14 into sections and/or teams, if the number of entries warrants.

For class 6a, rider/ horse combinations must not have obtained over 63% in any other EFA dressage test of this level or above. This class is to encourage less experience riders.

For other classes Rules may be posted during the Show prior to the start of the respective class.

For all classes warming up is only permitted in areas specifically designated for this purpose.

Instructions from Stewards and Officials are to be followed without delay, otherwise the competitor is liable to disqualification.

Appeals

Appeals against any judging decisions, placings or events impacting the results of any class must be lodged with the Show Director in writing within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the class results. All appeals must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which will be returned in the event the appeal is upheld.

The Appeals Committee will review all appeals and announce its decisions as soon as possible pending the time taken to gather and review evidence. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final.

- 3) To fully release, discharge and hold harmless the Organizer and its respective members, director, agents, employees, associates, staff and independent contractors from any claims, actions, liabilities and causes of action which I may now have or which may accrue as a result of or incidental to my voluntary participation in any of the sporting or non sporting activities incidental to or in connection with the Competition.

B) "Acknowledgement of Rules and Regulations"

- 1) To abide by all the rules and regulations of the organizer as in force from time to time;
- 2) To refrain from consuming alcoholic beverages or using any substances in a manner, which would decrease or impair my level of performance during my participation in the sporting activities of the competition
- 3) To refrain from un-sportsmanlike conduct or any conduct bringing discredit upon the competition including without limitation physically or verbally assaulting or abusing any official, competitor, spectator, volunteer or any person involved in the conduct and management of the competition and that any such conduct may meet with expulsion from the competition and appropriate criminal or civil action against me, and
- 4) To be filmed, photographed or interviewed as a participant in the competition when requested to do so by any officer or official of the organizer.

I acknowledge that I execute this 'General Release of Liability' freely and voluntary, and I do not rely on any inducements, promises or representations made by the aforementioned organization or individuals involved in the Competition, or any person associated in any way with the Competition.

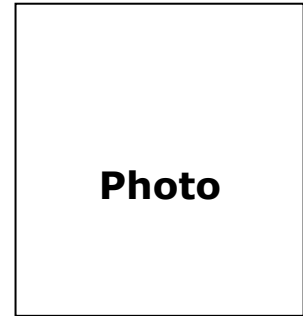
